* **The Vanderbilt-HK Institute of Education Conference** (known as an “**Institute**”) is a 5-day formal course conducted by highly qualified international educators. Completion of the course attracts 6 credits towards a HKIEd Masters of Educational Leadership. The Institute is expected to attract educational leaders from across the Asia-Pacific region. Presenters will include, Prof. Ellen Goldring (Vanderbilt University); Prof. Philip Hallinger HKIEd), Terry Quong (Australian, Principal of a large HK Secondary School). Prof. Allan Walker (HKIEd) and Cheng Yin Cheong (Vice President HKIEd). Details of the Program are available from the ISEA upon request.

There is a fee attached to attendance at this program (see Estimated Costs below). ISEA tour members will need to chose between participating in this program or taking part in the program of visits to Hong Kong schools and meetings with system officials. It will not be possible to combine the 2 options.

ESTIMATED COSTS (As of 14 February 2010, based on leaving Sydney Saturday 4 July and returning Thursday 15 July)

Flights Singapore Airlines: Sydney-Hong Kong-Singapore-Sydney = \$1250A pp

Accommodation: Hong Kong: Royal Park Hotel ,6 nights, twin-share with breakfast = \$ 396A pp

Singapore: York Hotel, Orchard, 6 nights twin-share with breakfast = \$ 300A pp

Internal Travel: Estimated for 10 days \$20A per-person per-day = \$ 200A pp

Total estimated costs, twin share = \$ 2,146A pp
(Single accommodation add \$630)

In addition members of the tour group will need to pay for transfers, travel insurance, tourist entries and some meals.

*The fee for participation in the Vanderbilt/HKIED Conference is \$1695A including tuition, papers and lunch for 5 days. Accommodation is not included.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR PAYMENT

International Flights. Sydney – Hong Kong – Singapore – Sydney to be arranged personally by tour members. The ISEA will seek out the best possible options and refer members to them.

Accommodation: The ISEA will make and pay for accommodation bookings in Hong Kong and Singapore and tour members will be invoiced by the ISEA prior to the beginning of the tour.

Internal Travel: Some institutions visited will provide internal travel for the tour group. Otherwise the cost estimated above should cover, taxis, shuttles or public transport as required.

ISEA FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The ISEA will provide gifts to the institutions visited and the colleagues in Hong Kong and Singapore who have assisted in organising the tour.

The ISEA is willing to receive applications from its members for financial support to take part in the study tour. Applications to the Executive Officer at least 1 month before the tour begins.

Tour members should also explore the availability of support from the DET including transfer of duties, remembering that the tour is to be conducted within the NSW 2nd Term Vacation.
